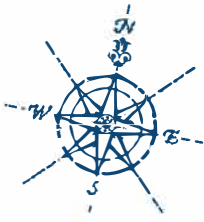

NOTE: The Certification of Origin has no prescribed format, but consists of a set of minimum data elements, which are set out in Annex 5-A of the Origin Procedures Chapter 5 of the CUSMA. The Certification of Origin may be completed by either the EXPORTER, PRODUCER or IMPORTER of the goods. It may be provided on an invoice or any other document & may be completed & submitted electronically, or for your convenience you may use the above form, which has all the required elements.



**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING CERTIFICATION OF ORIGIN**

Tick the appropriate box indicating whether the Certifier is the Exporter, the Producer or the Importer.

State the Certifier's name, address (incl. Country), telephone number and email address.

Provide the Exporter's name, address (incl. Country), telephone number and email address if different from the Certifier. Not required if unknown. The address of the Exporter shall be the place of export of the good(s) in a Party's territory - a CUSMA / US MCA/ T-MEC country.

Provide the Producer's name, address (incl. Country), telephone number and email address if different from the Certifier or Exporter, or if there are multiple Producers state 'Various' or provide a list of the Producers. If confidential, state 'Available upon request by the importing authorities'. The address of the Producer shall be in the place of production of the good(s) in a CUSMA / USMCA / T-MEC country.

Provide the Importer's name, address, telephone number and email address. Not required if Unknown. The address of the importer shall be in a CUSMA / US MCA/ T-MEC country.

Provide the H.S. Tariff Classification number code of the good(s) to the 6 digit level.

Provide a description of the good(s) sufficient to identify the good(s) covered by the shipment. If the certification of origin covers a single shipment of good(s), indicate, if known, the invoice number related to the exportation.

Specify the Origin Criteria (see below) under which the good(s) qualifies as set in Annex 4.2 (Originating Goods).

Include the blanket period if the certification covers multiple shipments of identical goods for a specified period of up to 12 months as set out in Article 5.2 of Chapter 5 of the CUSMA/ USMCA/ T-MEC. This certification must be signed and dated by the Certifier. By signing this certification the certifier confirms they are familiar with Chapter 5 Origin Procedures, Article 5.2 & Annex 5-A of the agreement and the products listed qualify under CUSMA / USMCA / T-MEC.

**ORIGIN CRITERIA**

Wholly obtained or produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties, as defined in Article 4.3 (Wholly Obtained or Produced Goods);	A
Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties using non-originating materials provided the good satisfies all applicable requirements of Annex 4-B (Product-Specific Rules of Origin);	B
Produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties exclusively from originating materials; or	C
Except for a good provided for in Chapter 61 to 63 of the Harmonized System: i. produced entirely in the territory of one or more of the Parties; ii. one or more of the non-originating materials provided for as parts under the Harmonized System used in the production of the good cannot satisfy the requirements set out in Annex 4-B (Product-Specific Rules of Origin) because both the good and its materials are classified in the same subheading or same heading that is not further subdivided into subheadings or, the good was imported into the territory of a Party in an unassembled or a disassembled form but was classified as an assembled good pursuant to rule 2(a) of the General Rules of Interpretation of the Harmonized System; and iii. the regional value content of the good, determined in accordance with Article 4.5 (Regional Value Content), is not less than 60 percent if the transaction value method is used, or not less than 50 percent if the net cost method is used;	D
